1	The total number of sections of the school from class I to XII shall be restricted to 22 of which not more than 6 sections may be used for senior secondary classes. The optimum number of students shall be restricted to 40 for a classrooms size of 500 sq ft and above. Further, the increase of sections shall be subject to specific approval of the Board based on the request of the school as per affiliation bye law and availability of classrooms of greater than 500 sq ft dimension
2	The school is directed to run atleast 01 section each of bal-vatika I, II & III subject to the maximum bal-vatika permitted vide Board's circular no. 12/2023 dated 24-03-2023 & 25/2023 dated 11-09-2023.
3	The recognition certificate is in vernacular medium. The school is required to submit its notarized translation in compliance within 03 months.
